Level 2: Genesis Supervisor

What is Level 2: Genesis Supervisor training?

Many people who take the Level 1: Genesis Coach training have asked for another course to strengthen their skills in Genesis counseling. This course is the answer! However, it is more than just an advanced level Genesis coach training. It is called “Genesis Supervisor Training” because those who complete it will have the expertise to assure that Genesis is being used optimally within their organization.

What will I learn?

Those who go through the training will learn:

- Mastery of the 10 skills of effective Genesis coaches
- Tips for supervising other Genesis Coaches, groups and classes within their organization
- How to create basic Genesis skills trainings for their staff team or volunteers
- How to use the Genesis tools in the Appendix of the 2023 Training Manual
- New information on neurobiology of addiction and recovery

How Long is the Course?

There are **8 training objectives** in this course that will take between **6 – 12 months** to complete. Many of the training objectives require you to bring examples from your coaching with clients for review and discussion. You will also be part of an online community where you can ask questions, build networks, and be mentored by Genesis experts.

What are the 8 Training Objectives?

1. Pass the **Genesis Coach Post Test**. (Those who took the Coach Training by On-Demand have already completed this.)
2. Receive a passing grade for the new **Client Study**. This is based on your work as a Genesis Coach with an actual client in the relapse prevention workbook. We strongly recommend that the primary addiction is to drugs or alcohol. *This is a new version of the Client Study, and not the same as the one previously used for the Certified Genesis Counselor requirement.*
3. Be part of the online Genesis Community group and attend a minimum of **6 virtual Monthly Mentoring Meetups**.
4. Submit a brief **book report** from a suggested reading in the Genesis Training Manual
5. Create **1 in-house training** of a Genesis coaching skill or worksheet.
6. Create **1 Bible teaching** that uses Genesis concepts.
7. Submit a brief paper on what **grace-based treatment** means to you, and how you will practice it.
8. Receive a passing grade for the **new classes**.

What will I gain by becoming a Level 2: Genesis Supervisor?

This training will build on the skills and competencies you learned in the Level 1: Genesis Coach training. It will be especially useful for anyone who uses Genesis as a clinical counselor, the Genesis expert in a recovery team, and the Genesis overseer in a church ministry. Those who complete the course will be able to:

- Be **endorsed by Genesis** as a Genesis best-practices provider of Genesis relapse prevention counseling. Only Level 2 people will be eligible to become virtual Genesis coaches when this offering is developed after the launch of the new Faster scale App.
- **Guide (facilitate) local groups** going through the on-demand Genesis Coach Training.
- **Supervise the facilitators of change groups** and add a dimension of individual Genesis coaching for group members who need to go deeper.
- **Teach the basic Genesis skills** to other staff and volunteers within their organization
- **Provide expertise** and quality assurance for the use of Genesis within their organization.
- Understand how to **use the tools and resources found in the Appendix** of the 2023 Training Manual.
- Learn more discoveries in neuroscience, and some new trends in addiction counseling that enhance Genesis.

Who is eligible to go through this training?

Anyone who has been through the **Level 1: Genesis Coach Training** and

- Has taken the Level 1 training within the past 7 years
- Is currently working as a Genesis Coach
- Has worked with clients for a minimum of 6 months
- At least one client's primary addiction is drugs and alcohol

What if I am already a Certified Genesis Counselor?

Thank you for your commitment and service! However, Level 2: Genesis Supervisor is a completely different certification standard with different case study requirements. If you want to be a Level 2 Genesis Supervisor you will need to take this training.

What materials will I need?

You will need your Genesis Workbook, Training Manual (2023 version), and 1 client whose work you can submit for the case studies and exercises. You will also need reliable access to computer and internet. There may be additional materials added once the classes are finalized.

What is the cost?

The introductory cost is **\$650 + non-refundable \$25 application fee**. Why an application? We want to make sure you meet the prerequisites of the course before paying the full fee.

Is this course accredited for CEU's?

This course is not endorsed by any particular state board, but like the Genesis Coach training, you may be able to submit the course description and have CEU's assigned.
